Leading

Involves running the service and ensuring that each of the people rostered for different things can make it. It also involves putting together the PowerPoint presentation and liaising with the preacher, & (the musicians) which songs will be played. It also requires a 'Kids Spot' to be organised (this can involve asking a Sunday school teacher or using a video). Arrive early, & turn everything on - lights, sound etc.! Pray from 8:45am.

Bible Reading

Make sure you have looked over the passage and checked how to say any tough words and practiced reading it aloud several times before the service.

When you're at the lectern, announce the passage you are reading & the page number so everyone can find it in the pew bibles. And leave enough time for everyone to find the passage first. If you still hear pages rustling, then just wait a bit longer.

Make sure you are reading the same version as the pew bibles, please!

Do not read any headings! If you need to introduce some context to where we find the passage, please do so in your own words. (Headings are the editorial words of men, & can actually be misleading, so let's not confuse what is the word of God & what is from editors.)

Prayers

The way prayers are led publicly in Church impacts the nature and shape of Church attenders' prayer lives.

An excellent model of praying includes far more than just requests. With this in mind, a suitable model for leading public prayers is the **ACTS** model (**A**doration, **C**onfession, **T**hanksgiving, **S**upplication).

Another option is '**tsp**' (Thanks, Sorry, Please).

No long intros, & if praying after the sermon, be mindful of trying to pray in line with what we have heard/been challenged by.

Let the service leader know if you intend to pray the Lord's Prayer so he can insert slides for all to follow.

Welcomers

Set a joyous tone for the gathering of God's people & enjoy the opportunity to serve our gracious God & His flock.

Be early, & check with the service leader or Paul as to what people need to be given on the way in.

Note any concerns people mention & check with Paul or a Parish Councillor whether they are aware of those concerns.

Projector / Sound Desk

This involves clicking through the PowerPoint on the computer at the right time and assisting with setting up and packing up the computer and the sound desk.

Check to see if there are any music, video or special presentations that require extra fiddling on the computer.

Please try & arrive around 9:10am, & make sure the sound system is working, the levels are acceptable & batteries are in the microphones.

Sunday School

Involves teaching our primary age children God's Word, so please be prepared, & know the passage. Michelle leads this ministry, so please talk with her about questions & particularly if you could not organise a swap. Make sure the children are signed in by a parent or carer.

Morning Tea

Those listed on the roster are to set up & make sure everything is tidy & back in its place at the end of morning tea.

Hopefully, others will help during the morning.

Hopefully, people not on the roster will bring food to share.
